Be sure to contextualize your projections in the light of the mission and goals of your institution.

Conference Outline

As always, the conference will be highly interactive. We will have a short introduction on Monday night and a panel of Writing Program Administrators from one school or a group of similar schools.

On Tuesday morning, we will have two more panels from two more school types talking about writing program's there and their futures. We will work in small groups, sharing ideas and problems on Tuesday morning, afternoon, and evening.

On Wednesday, we will come together to present issues that we have discussed.

As always there will be plenty of free time to meet informally with colleagues.

Registration Fee

The conference will cost \$165 for a two-person room. One-person rooms are available on a very limited basis for an additional cost. This registration fee includes everything but travel to Wildacres: room, food, and materials. The registration deadline is **August 15.
