- 5. Image Manipulations
 - Adobe Photoshop
 - Understand cropping, borders and image/canvas size adjustments
 - Understand tonal and color correction/manipulation

Requirements:

- 1. Choose ten images from the 100 you took in the previous homework assignment. The ten you choose should be ones you are considering for use in Project 2.
- 2. Use the cropping, image size, canvas size and transformation tools to isolate and/or size the images to the approximate size you will need for Project 2.
- 3. Use the various image adjustment tools available in Photoshop to broadly color and/or tonally correct each image.
- 4. Use the dodge, burn, and sponge tools on the toolbar to further color and/or tonally correct each image in specific areas.
- 5. Name each image with a name that represents it's potential use in your final composite image for Project 2.
- 6. Save each image out as both a Photoshop file (.psd) and a TIFF file (.tif).
- 7. Place the ten pairs of images (20 total) into a folder labeled with your name and the word "manipulations: (i.e. phillip_motley_manipulations).
- 8. Copy your completed folder to Quicksilver in the "Homework Submissions" folder (put your file in "Assignment 5", which is in our COM 220 class folder)
