## **Homework Assignments:**

- 10. Video graphics
  - Photoshop
  - Design graphics for use as overlays for video content
  - Learn how to design within video constraints

## **Requirements:**

- 1. This assignment requires three parts: opening title graphic, a template for lower third graphics, and closing credit graphics
- 2. Each person on a video team will design one of the three needed components
- 3. Use Photoshop to design your title, lower third or closing credit graphics.
- 4. Create a new file in Photoshop. Choose Film and Video from the "Preset" dropdown menu. Choose "HDTV 1080p/29.97" from the size menu. That should create an image that matches the pixel dimensions of the footage you shot.
- 5. Design all elements in RGB color mode
- 6. Make sure to design within title and action safe margins (hold down cmd and; keys to toggle on/off the title and action safe guides)
- 7. Make sure not to use thin graphic elements, especially horizontal lines (including horizontal serif elements that are part of serif-based fonts)
- 8. Design all content on layers other than the default background layer in Photoshop.
- 9. Save file as a PSD file and as a TIFF file.
