

## NatureSounds of Panama – Dave Gammon

All recordings were made while working with David Logue in Gamboa, Panama on duetting behavior in the black-bellied wren May to August 2002. Recordings were made onto a Sony portable minidisc recorder model MZ-R700 using a Sennheiser ME62 microphone mounted in a Telinga Pro-Universal parabola. I ordered the birdsong tracks according to Ridgely and Gwynne's Birds of Panama, 2<sup>nd</sup> edition checklist (pp. 25-49). Thanks to Randy Moore, David Logue, and George Angehr's set of birdsong tapes for helping me to identify several of the species I was unfamiliar with.
